RESERVED AREAS

Northland

All land above the line of mean high water springs between 35° 03' 00" S and 35° 42' 00" S.

Great Barrier (Aotea) Island

All of mainland Great Barrier Island (Aotea) (above the line of mean high water springs).

Coromandel Peninsula

All land above the line of mean high water springs that is south of 36° 39' 00" S and north of the Kopu – Hikuai Rd.

East Nelson

All that area of land bounded by straight lines between the geographical coordinates (NZGD 2000) commencing at a point:

All that area of land bounded by straight lines between the geographical coordinates (NZGD 2000) commencing at a point:

3	42° 03' 00" S	173° 45' 00" E	Then west to
4	42° 03' 00" S	173° 33' 30" E	Then north to point 1

Paparoa

All land gazetted as Paparoa National Park.

South Westland

All that area of land bounded by straight lines between the geographical coordinates (NZGD 2000) commencing at a point:

2	43° 43' 20" S	170° 05' 10" E	Then northwest to
3	43° 27' 54" S	169° 45' 35.270" E	Then southwest along the coast to

Longwood Range

All that area of land bounded by straight lines between the geographical coordinates (NZGD 2000) commencing at a point:

3	46° 20' 20" S	167° 56' 00" E	Then west to

Stewart Island (Rakiura)

All of mainland Stewart Island/Rakiura (above the line of mean high water springs).
