Discontinuous Siltstones

There is effectively 100% connectivity of sandstone beds due to the continuous nature of the siltstone beds. From the limited 3D exposure, bed geometries are observed: a) Siltstone beds with a sheet like erosional amalgamation holes/surfaces through them (Fig. 6A).
