

Permit 55792 - Offshore, Great South Basin South-Canterbury

This offshore exploration permit has been awarded to New Zealand Oil and Gas Developments Limited (NZOG).

NZOG have committed to either: acquire/licence 20 sq km of 3D seismic data in the Great South Basin and reprocess existing 2D seismic data within a year from next April. If results are positive this may lead to exploration drilling.

About the permit area

This permit covers 1,654.4 km² off the south-east coast of the South Island. The area the permit is in was included in the tender as part of Offshore Release Area 13GSC-R1.

Consultation undertaken

Prior to the launch of Block Offer 2013 NZP&M consulted iwi, hapū and councils in the relevant areas. Six submissions were received. Five were from iwi/hapū and one from a local authority. Iwi stated that they were likely to be actively involved in the consenting process for activity both under the RMA and the EEZ.
