## **Proposed Work Programme**

## **Stage 1 (Committed Activities):**

Within **12** months of the commencement date of the permit, the permit holder shall (to the satisfaction of the chief executive):

- 1 Complete the following activities which are all **key deliverables** for the purposes of the Petroleum Programme:
  - (a) obtain land access and resource consents, select a drilling contractor and source drilling materials; and
  - (b) either:
    - (i) notify the chief executive in writing of the permit holder's commitment to carry out the next stage of the work programme; or
    - (ii) surrender the permit.

## **Stage 2 (Contingent Activities)**

Within **36** months of the commencement date of the permit, the permit holder shall (to the satisfaction of the chief executive):

- 2 Complete the following activities which are all **key deliverables** for the purposes of the Petroleum Programme:
  - (a) drill the Te Ohaki-1 and Te Ohaki-2 horizontal wells to test the Renown and Kupakupa coal seams.

Within 48 months of the commencement date of the permit, the permit holder shall (to the satisfaction of the chief executive):

- Complete the following activities which are all **key deliverables** for the purposes of the Petroleum Programme:
  - (a) flow test the Te Ohaki-1 and Te Ohaki-2 wells utilising a mobile cogeneration plant; and
  - (b) relinquish 50% of the original permit area.
